POLICY FOR A DRUG-FREE DISTRICT

Reference: Title V-D of Public Law 100-690, Sections 5151-5160, the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988
Public Law 101-226, the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989
Campus Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990, 20 U.S.C. 1092

It is the policy of the Long Beach Community College District to implement PL 100-690 and 101-226 and to comply with the requirements of the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990. The District will make a good faith effort to maintain a drug-free workplace and institute a drug prevention program for students and employees. The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, use, or sale of illicit drugs and alcohol is prohibited by all employees and students in all buildings, property, facilities, service areas, and satellite centers of the District or as part of any District activities. Any student or employee violating this policy will be subject to disciplinary action which may include completion of an appropriate rehabilitation program or expulsion or termination. The District encourages the development of drug abuse education programs.
