This Associate Degree will prepare students for career advancement and will also facilitate transfer to a four-year college or university.

The Commercial Music's, Instrumental and/or Vocal mission is to provide academic (AA degrees) and personal preparation for successful transfer to a university by providing General Education, Humanities and Arts courses necessary to fulfill transfer requirements or to successfully gain employment in the music and media entertainment industry by providing, to the community at large, meaningful and vital performance experience and opportunity.
