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Student Process

- 1. Final Year (Senior) Students to submit an application to Fashion Department Chair for preliminary judging.
 - Two to three completed designs per student
 - A photograph of each garment to accompany the application
 - Submissions may come from prior school projects
- Each Fashion Department Chair will offer <u>three</u> chosen candidates the opportunity to submit their online presentation utilizing power point presentations via Google docs (example attached) by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>April 11th</u>, <u>2019</u>
- 3. Industry expert judges will select the student design winners. Winners to be announced **Monday**, **April 22**nd, **2019**.
 - One student per school will be eligible to receive CFF Scholarships.
 - Awardees and their educators will be invited to attend the Scholarship Luncheon at the California Market Center in Los Angeles on May 2nd, as guests of CFF.
- 4. <u>Two</u> designs of the winning student will be displayed at the luncheon. Students to deliver garments on-to California Market Center Fashion Theater.
