These requirements are designed for students planning to transfer to the California State University (CSU). Courses on this pattern are lower-division general education breadth requirements specific to the California State University System and used to obtain full or partial certification.

Students planning to transfer to the University of California should refer to the IGETC General Education Pattern (Plan C). Students planning to earn associate degree and NOT transfer should follow Plan A. Both Plans A and C are accessible at http://www.lbcc.edu/general-education-patterns. AREA REQUIREMENTS
