A campus safety plan shall be developed and provided to students on the College website.

The Director, Risk Management and Campus Safety prepares and annually updates a report of all occurrences reported to campus safety of, and arrests for, crimes that are committed on campus and that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and of all occurrences of noncriminal acts of hate violence reported to campus authorities. A written report will be submitted to the Board of Trustees.

Written records of noncriminal acts of hate violence shall comply with Clery reporting requirements.
