BP 3570 NO SMOKING AND TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT

The District shall provide a safe and healthy environment for its students, employees, and visitors. In light of evidence that the use of tobacco and nicotine and exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol (commonly referred to as "vapor") from electronic devices pose significant health and environmental hazards, the District has established a smoke, vapor-, and tobacco-free environment.

Smoking of any kind, including use of electronic devices, and all uses of tobacco are prohibited on all property and in all indoor and outdoor spaces owned, leased, licensed, or otherwise controlled by the District, and in all District-owned vehicles.
