POLICY ON CRIME PREVENTION, REPORTING,  
AND CAMPUS SECURITY

Reference: Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990, 20 U.S.C. 1092  
Education Code Section 67380

It is the policy of Long Beach Community College District to comply with the requirements of the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990 enacted by Congress. It is the District's policy to:

1. Contract with a local law enforcement agency.
2. Provide procedures for students and staff to report criminal activities and other emergencies on campus and to provide procedures for responding to those reports.
3. Maintain a video surveillance system that can be used to investigate alleged crimes and/or incidences occurring on campus.
4. Inform students and employees about campus security procedures and to encourage students and employees to be responsible for their own security and the security of others.
5. Provide programs informing students and employees about the prevention of crime.
6. Publish an annual statistical report concerning the occurrence of crime on the campus and the number of arrests for various crimes occurring on college campuses. Such reports will be made available as required by law.
7. Provide an atmosphere of openness for the encouragement of collegiate activity on campus facilities balanced by controls on access to campus facilities designed to promote security of campus facilities.
