Student & Family Expectations

Student Expectations

We uphold our dual enrollment students to the same expectations that we do for our greater LBCC student population. Here are the expectations for our dual enrollment students:

- Check your email and LBCC Canvas on a daily basis
- Store your LBCC Viking Portal Login credentials on your phone
- Read the entire course syllabus for each college course, notate important dates and assignments
- Reach out to your instructor immediately if you are having difficulty in the class by email, LBCC Canvas or visit during the instructor's office hours
- Dedicate least 1 hour of class preparation/study outside of class for each unit the class is worth (i.e. 3unit class = 3hrs. of studying)
- A non-passing grade (D, F, W, EW, etc.) can negatively affect your eligibility for financial aid when you become a full-time college students. Your grades become part of your permanent college transcripts, no matter what school you attend.

Family Expectations

Family involvement is integral to the success of dual enrollment students, however, we recognize that limitations may apply. Here is how families can support:

- Encourage your student to securely store their LBCC Viking Portal login credentials in their phone
- Encourage your students to read and check their emails daily
- Check in/discuss progress on a weekly basis with your student about their dual enrollment class
- Encourage your student to reach out to their LBCC instructor as issues or conflicts arise and to utilize professor's office hours
- Advise your student to meet and speak with their high school counselor and/or LBCC counselor prior to dropping/withdrawing from any dual enrollment class.
- In accordance with FERPA, **college officials may only assist the LBCC student with access to their LBCC student portal**
