To The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges Committee on Substantive Change:

Long Beach City College has identified the need to submit a Substantive Change Application for Distance Education. While this application is specifically for a Change in Mode of Delivery for the College's Psychology Associate in Arts for Transfer degree, the College has approved additional courses to be offered in a distance education modality (i.e., online or hybrid) for other degrees and certificates. While additional courses are approved to be offered through distance education, many of them are not currently being offered in this modality. Thus, while technically some of the College's degrees and certificates could be offered 50 percent or more through distance education based on distance education course approvals, none of these programs are currently being marketed, or advertised to students as such. Long Beach City would like to inform the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges of these awards:
